**Rocom Corporation's RoHS Compliance Policy**

**DIRECTIVE 2002/96/EC OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 27 January 2003 on the recycling of Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE)**

And

**DIRECTIVE 2002/95/EC OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 27 January 2003 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.**

The above legislation, also referred to as "Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS)" restricts the use of the following substances in new electrical and electronic equipment sold in the Union from 1 July 2006:

- Lead
- Mercury
- Hexavalent Chromium
- Cadmium
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB's)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE's)

Directive 2002/95/EC provides exemptions for these materials with specific maximum concentration levels, however, the EU Technical Adaptation Committee (TAC) has issued further guidance on maximum permissible concentration levels of these substances as follows:

Lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, PBB's and PBDE's will be tolerated to a maximum concentration value of 0.1% by weight, and cadmium to a maximum concentration value of 0.01% by weight, in homogeneous materials.

Although none of the products manufactured by Rocom Corporation are directly covered under the RoHS directive, Rocom Corporation acknowledge that a small percentage of our products will be used in systems that are covered under the RoHS directive and we are proud to support in spirit and practice the RoHS directive.

It is the policy of Rocom Corporation to offer only RoHS compliant products to our customers unless some deviation is required, and specifically called out by a customer that might make a product non compliant.

Rocom Corporation performs no testing of the components, raw materials, or outside processes used in it's products and relies solely on the manufacturers, distributors, and process vendors for conformation of RoHS compliance.

Rocom Corporation will conduct, on an annual basis, a RoHS compliance survey of all vendors supplying components, raw material, and outside processes that will evidently become part of our products and will maintain records of these surveys with all due diligence.

Rocom Corporation makes no warranty or guarantee of accuracy of the claims or statements of it's vendors and will not accept responsibility for any inaccurate, false, or fraudulent claims made by it's vendors regarding RoHS compliance.
